2 elephants relocated to Terengganu National Park

TANAH MERAH: The Wildlife and National Parks Department (Perhilitan) on Sunday relocated two female elephants from Kampung Kuala Tiga, here, to the National Park in Terengganu. Kuala Gandah National Elephant Conservation Centre chief Che Ku Mohd Zamzuri Chik Wan Ab Rahman said relocating the elephants, aged 5 and 15, and weighing one tonne and two tonnes respectively, took eight hours and involved 36 Perhilitan and conservation centre staff. He said the elephants were caught last Friday using tranquilisers after complaints from villagers. Che Ku Mohd Zamzuri said the elephants were believed to be from a herd in Kampung Air Kerilla forest reserve near the village, which came out to forage for food. **Bernama**
