7 WILDLIFE OFFENDERS NABBED IN SABAH

KOTA KINABALU: Seven wildlife offenders have been arrested in the first 15 days of this year through joint operations mounted by the General Operation Force, the Sabah Forestry Department and the Sabah Wildlife Department, Deputy Chief Minister Datuk Christina Liew revealed. She said while the success was extremely encouraging, questions about the offenders' partners, their networks and resources to perpetrate these crimes need to be answered. Liew said wildlife-related crimes are not just a local problem but part of an international wildlife trade syndicate associated with drug and human trafficking as well as money laundering.
