Experts to study damage to Gua Matsoorat fossils

IPOH: The Ipoh City Council has not determined the amount of compensation to be paid by a film production company that damaged fossils at Gua Matsoorat during filming. Mayor Datuk Rumaizi Baharin said the council needed time to determine the amount as the damage involved the fossil teeth of a herbivorous mammal, which requires studies by a palaeontology team. "We have asked the team to submit its findings. This is not a simple task as it involves a prehistoric species that requires palaeontologists to conduct studies to determine the value of the damage," he said after visiting an urban farming complex at Gunung Matsoorat here yesterday. Gua Matsoorat is set to be the 19th geosite under the Kinta Valley Geopark.
