MHHE West gets mega solar power installation

KUALA LUMPUR: Malaysia Marine and Heavy Engineering Holdings Bhd's (MHB) operation yard, MMHE West, in Pasir Gudang, Johor, is now powered by solar energy.

MHB said this followed the installation of a rooftop solar photovoltaic (PV) system by Petroliam Nasional Bhd (Petronas) using its very own solar solution brand M+.

The installation of the 8.3-megawatt peak system also represented the largest rooftop solar PV system installation in a single compound in Malaysia, said MHB.

It said the 18,720 units of solar PV panels with a total size of 440,496 sq ft would provide energy for eight buildings at MMHE West.

These panels will generate an estimated 10,000-megawatt-hours of clean energy per year.

MHB estimated the system would allow it to save up to RM30 million in electricity bills over 21 years.

Managing director and chief executive officer Pandai Othman said the company would be able to reduce its carbon footprint by utilising renewable energy solutions.

"As part of our mission to preserve the environment and create a difference in people's lives, our efforts are not only for the company's profit but also for the benefit of all."

Pandai said the company had other environmental sustainability efforts in place, including energy-saving initiatives, waste management and water conservation.

"We acknowledge the dynamics of the energy industry and have expanded our strategies in exploring opportunities in the renewable energy sector, which include the construction of offshore wind farm structures.
