## Ministry monitors wildlife sanctuary encroachment

KUCHING — The Natural Resources and Environment Ministry will monitor encroachment into the Samunsan wildlife sanctuary near Telok Melano along the border with Camar Bulan in West Kalimantan.

Its minister, Datuk Seri Dr Wan Junaidi

Thanku Jaafar, said this is because the measuring of the border with Indonesia or any other countries was under the purview of his ministry.

He also pointed out that the ministry would give serious attention to the encroachment of between 2,000 and 5,000 sq m of the area

by Indonesians for the planting of pepper and rubber.

“Because the matter is under the purview of my ministry, we view it (encroachment) along the border very seriously, but we are giving the trust to the Third Infantry Brigade to discuss with Indonesian National Army,”

Wan Junaidi told the *Borneo Post* yesterday.

Third Infantry Brigade Commander Brigadier-General Mohd Bustaman Mat Zin recently said the encroachment had been detected during a joint patrol by General Operations Force and Sarawak Forestry Corporation.
