Pahang Regent: Do more to save our forests

PEKAN: The Regent of Pahang, Tengku Abdullah Sultan Ahmad Shah, has called on the Forestry Department to implement more policies and programmes related to forest conservation.

He said that even though logging is undeniably a source of revenue for the state, logging activities should be managed properly to limit damage to the surrounding forests and environment.

"Illegal logging has been the main problem... and we are all trying to find ways to

put a stop to this," he said after the DRB-Hicom University of Automotive Malaysia 5th Convocation Ceremony here yesterday.

Tengku Abdullah was commenting on calls by residents of Janda Baik, Bentong near here, urging the authorities to pay attention to problems of development and effects of logging activities in the area.

At the ceremony, 707 graduates received their diplomas and certificates, the highest number ever recorded since the university's first convocation ceremony. — Bernama
