Reservoir Link unit bags RM8.42m solar project in Terengganu from Solar Bina

KUALA LUMPUR: Reservoir Link Energy Bhd's 51 per cent-owned unit, Founder Energy Sdn Bhd, has bagged a RM8.42 million purchase order from Solar Bina Engineering Sdn Bhd.

Reservoir Link said in a statement yesterday it would under-

take subcontracting works of installation, testing and communication of photovoltaic modules, inverter, DC cables and associated works for a 100MW large scale solar photovoltaic project in Marang, Terengganu.

The contract, which started

yesterday, is expected to be completed within six months.

Reservoir Link had on Aug 11 announced the acquisition of a 51 per cent stake in Founder Energy.

Reservoir Link executive director Thien Chiet Chai said this was

its first solar photovoltaic contract as the company pursued its energy transition goals.

"This contract is a testament to our plans since the successful acquisition of Founder Energy," he said.

"With it, Reservoir Link's solar

renewable energy order book will increase to RM32.77 million, driven by the upward trajectory of solar energy demand and government initiative for large scale solar projects and the Net Energy Metering 3.0 programme," he added.
