Solarvest secures contract to build largest LSS plant in Perlis

KUALA LUMPUR: Clean energy specialist Solarvest Holdings Bhd has secured a large-scale solar (LSS) project worth RM175 million under the LSS@Mentari programme.

The contract, awarded by Classic Solar Farm Sdn Bhd, will see Solarvest building the largest LSS plant in Perlis.

Solarvest said it will undertake the main engineering, procurement, construction and commission (EPCC) works for the 50-megawatt solar farm in Chuping.

The latest contract increases Solarvest's EPCC orders from the LSS@Mentari programme to about RM371 million.

Group chief executive officer Davis Chong Chun Shiong said the project's clean energy generation will offset about 78,450 tonnes of carbon dioxide per year.

"We are thrilled to be entrusted to build yet another landmark project and help unlock clean energy from the northern region. With this project win, our un-

billed order book has increased to RM583 million, probably one of the largest solar EPCC order book in Malaysia," he said in a statement yesterday.

Chong said it would be busy year ahead for Solarvest.

"The group is collectively tendering for about 1,000-megawatt peak worth of projects across Malaysia, Taiwan and the Philippines. In tandem with the growth plans, we are scaling up our workforce to cater to the rising demand," he added.



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
