# Tuas Power, Nefin eye Singapore electricity deal

**KUALA LUMPUR:** Singapore’s Tuas Power Ltd has partnered with Nefin Group to jointly bid for 100 MW of zero-carbon electricity import from Malaysia.

The energy solutions and multi-utilities provider said yesterday it had signed a memorandum of understanding (MoU) last month with Nefin, a leading solar photovoltaic developer and investor in carbon neutrality solutions.

The partnership allows both to support the island republic’s move to boost its energy security

by leveraging regional power grids.

Tuas Power chief operating officer Michael Wong said it was finding a sustainable and reliable blend of electricity generated from renewable and fuel-based sources to feed into the national grid.

He said Tuas Power sought to address the intermittency of solar power during non-generating hours.

Tuas Power has a large pool of customers from the data centre, semiconductor and petrochemi-

cal industries, which are interested to take up the clean energy import.

Nefin business development head and Nefin Malaysia managing director Bor Hung Chong said the group was a market leader in distributed solar project developments in Malaysia.

“We have many customers who have signed power purchase agreements lasting for up to 20 years.”
