SG SEMENYIH POLLUTION

Water cuts in 348 areas

KUALA LUMPUR: The Sungai Semenyih Water Treatment Plant had to be shut down yesterday following an odour pollution in Sungai Semenyih.

The management of Air Selangor Sdn Bhd said the shutdown would result in 348 areas with 328,957 consumer accounts in Petaling, Hulu Langat, Kuala Langat and Sepang experiencing unscheduled water cuts.

It said a river monitoring team from Air Selangor and Lembaga Urus Air Selangor (Luas) had been mobilised to identify the source of the odour pollution in Sungai Semenyih and its tributaries.

Air Selangor activated the emergency response plan to help customers.

Air Selangor said it could not be sure when the plant would be operational again and water supply could resume as it would depend on the level of pollution.

The cause of the pollution and the parties responsible for it were being identified.
