Water supply restored to 35,000 Muar residents

JOHOR BARU: Water supply to 35,000 consumers in Muar has been fully restored five days after ammonia pollution was detected in Sungai Muar. Johor International Trade, Investment and Utilities Committee chairman Jimmy Puah Wee Tse said the supply was fully restored on Sunday, but water service operator Ranhill SAJ was working on improving the water quality. "Ranhill SAJ is working to ensure better water quality, and the process of water quality rehabilitation also depends on the quality of raw water from the river." Detected on Dec 31, the pollution was believed to have been caused by contaminants from an industrial effluent retention pond in the Segamat II industrial estate that flowed into Sungai Kenawar, Sungai Chodan and Sungai Muar.
