RM1.34 MILLION FUND

Woman grateful for TNB aid

KUALA LUMPUR: Ghayah Mat Daud, 63, from Pantai Dalam here, was delighted to receive financial aid from Tenaga Nasional Bhd's Tabung Warga TNB Prihatin.

"Only Allah can repay the kindness of the people who gave this aid, which came when we are struggling and trying our best to survive.

"I am relieved because now I can settle some overdue bills, such as utility bills and rent. I have also received other aid in kind, but I gave the food aid to others, especially those with many young children who need it more than me."

Nearly 12,300 TNB staff helped raise RM1.34 million for the Bottom 40 per cent group who were impacted by Covid-19.

TNB staff made voluntary salary deductions for the months of June and July to

contribute to the fund and the TNB management matched every ringgit so that more people could benefit from the aid.

The first round of aid totalling RM270,000 was distributed on June 20.

The funds will be distributed in stages to recipients in the peninsula.

Recipients are selected from the B40 group, including people with disabilities and those identified from the e-Kasih system, Welfare Department, state Zakat Centre and from TNB staff feedback.

Since the beginning of the year, TNB has reached out to more than 10,000 people with an allocation of almost RM9.5 million to rebuild old and dilapidated houses and to distribute food aid, basic necessities and pocket money.
